WHAT IS THE GREAT EGG DROP?

To play: A Child, Family Team or an Adult will construct a protective covering for a raw egg, and then they will stand on the deck and drop the padded eggs onto a target below. Their goal is to hit the bull's eye or outer rings without breaking the eggs, racking up as many points as they can in the process. The drop zone will be on the patio behind the clubhouse.

Cushioning the eggs: All contestants will receive a kit of cushioning items —. At "Go," the kids have 30 seconds to grab an egg and supplies, and ten minutes to make a cushion using the materials.
