MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

JULY 2020

The Governor's restrictions have been lifted on beaches, and our summer season is finally now upon us; social/physical distancing is still required. The lake and properties are in great shape, and our social and event calendar has been modified to get some activities in for the summer.

The North Jersey Regional Lake League has decided to cancel the swim season this year due to COVID 19. The Swim Team committee is working on some alternative activities for the team to keep our swimmers active for the summer. More information, I am sure, will be announced shortly.

Lifeguarding started full time at 1st Beach and Tuesday, Thursday, and weekends at 3rd Beach. Please make sure you have your badges or wristband when on Club property. Boat and car stickers should be displayed, as well. Doing so will help to avoid any confusion and make it easier for Jaci, our Beach Security, to do her job.

I have to mention, as I have numerous times before, about clearing the beach & property during thunder & lightning storms. This is not a choice; it is part of our waterfront safety policy & procedure manual. If there is thunder, the water gets cleared. If there is lightning, the beach & property gets cleared, meaning you seek shelter in a car or building. No questions asked, please! Not sure why each year our guards seem to get a hard time from someone questioning the policy. IT IS FOR YOUR SAFETY!

I need to remind our residents that firework displays on Club property are prohibited. We will have extra security patrols on July 4th weekend to monitor. Please be courteous of your neighbors and their animals.

The Clubhouse renovations are almost complete and looking good. As I type, the interior is being painted; landscaping is coming along, and flooring and finishing touches are being completed. We hope to be up & running sometime in early July.

As our summer season begins, a couple standing rule reminders; please be sure your guests are aware as well, it is your responsibility to inform them. You must use a koozie or other foam insulator when using glass bottles on our properties. This rule is simply for the protection and safety of all with bare feet running around should the bottle fall and break on the ground. The Club has a carry in-carry out policy for personal trash (including plastic bottles!!) on all Club properties. I find our kids are the biggest culprits when it comes to leaving items around the property. So parents, if you give them a snack or drink, please monitor; I usually find lots of juice boxes and wrappers by the playground. Please be sure to review all our standing rules to avoid any confusion. All are posted on our webpage <https://www.lakeshawneeclub.org/members> (password:shawnee)

Our night security patrols will begin on July 4th, and I ask that all our residents and members do their part in making LS a safe and secure place to live. If you see suspicious persons or activity, please report to our local police. Every member has the right and obligation to question persons on Club property to inquire if they are members.

Summary of the Lake Shawnee Club Board Meeting June 5, 2020

It was reported the beaches have been open for the past 2 weekends with only a few minor issues with the COVID restrictions, specifically no guests.

It was reported at the Swim Team League meeting that the season will mostly likely be cancelled due to the current health crisis. Our Swim Team Committee is trying to determine alternate swim team activities to keep the kids involved. It was noted that the swim lanes have not yet been set up. In addition, the Tricky Tray fundraiser that had been planned for Community Day was also cancelled.

There was a brief discussion on rescheduling the Annual Meeting amid the current health crisis/social distancing regulations.

It was noted that there was not a decrease in paid memberships this year as we expected due to the current health crisis. There are currently 202 regular members and 142 senior members (344 total). The office staff have provided several dates and times for members to come to the Beach to pick up their badges.

The Social Committee has planned a graduation parade around the lake on June 19th and a Boat Parade at 2pm on June 20th in lieu of Community Day activities, which had to be cancelled due to current social distancing regulations. They have posted on the Lake Shawnee Facebook page and via email blast to inform the membership of upcoming activities.

The Lake Shawnee Scholarship committee reviewed and ranked 17 applications and 3 winners were determined. The JTHS guidance department asked scholarship donors to provide a short video to announce the winners which will be compiled and aired online on June 9th. The three winners will be announced in the LSNews in July. Ms. McConnon announced the three winners in advance to the Board - \$1000 to Ian McAndrew, \$750 to Samantha Iverson, and \$500 to Anjali Patel.

The LSNews will continue the monthly format until things get back to normal; hopefully by September they will resume every other month format. The website will be updated to include the most current information for members.

Summer Night Security patrols will begin in July. Extra shifts will be added as in year's past to monitor any fireworks on Club properties.

Lifeguards are up and running for the season. Ms. Kristin Iaconetti is still managing the guards and 5 new guard candidates were just certified. Ms. Jaclyn McConnon will be Summer Beach Security this year. Finally, it was noted that swim lessons are still planned for the season.

Work on Club properties include sand and QP spread, 2nd Beach gate repaired, and 2 handicap kayak racks installed at White's Cove.

There has been a lot of progress on the Clubhouse renovation and the budget for the project is in good shape. Currently, a completion date is unknown. The Board voted to have the interior professionally painted.

The status of the Snack Shack is on hold since it is currently being used for storage during the Clubhouse renovation. Once things are removed, Ms. Meisner will determine if they are able to open amid the current health/social distancing regulations.

**Lake Shawnee Club**  
**Boat Rules-Storage Policy**

1. **Boats are defined as;** any vessel including but not limited to any row boat, patio/deck boat, sailboat, canoe, paddle boat, kayak, paddle board or other watercraft.
  
2. **All boats** utilized on the lake or stored on any Club property are required to obtain a Club issued boat decal. Boat decals are valid through April 1st following a Presidential election year. The decal shall be valid for a period that does not exceed 4 years.
  - a. All Boat decals shall be affixed outside the vessel closest to the bow on either the port or starboard side.
  - b. Boats & watercraft cannot exceed 25 feet in length and cannot be capable of exceeding 15 mph.
  - c. Motorized boats must be electric powered only.
  - d. Member Guests launching boats on the lake shall have a guest badge in possession and present upon request.
  - e. Any boat & trailer launched into the lake must be clean and free of weeds.
  
3. **Boats stored on Club Property:**
  - a. Any member wishing to store a boat on Club property shall complete a boat storage permit at the Club Office. Storage permits will be issued on a first come first serve basis; assigned by property stored and valid for the requested property only. Should a member wish to move their boat to another property they must first notify the Club Office.
  - b. Boats stored on Club property are to be stored on designated boat racks and in designated areas only. No boats are to be stored on the ground and will result in removal from the property.
  - c. Boat owners storing boats on Club property are responsible to remove any water from boats within 48 hours of any rain event.
  - d. All boats are to be removed from Club property by November 1st of any Presidential election year and can be returned after April 1st once a new storage permit is completed.
  - e. Sailboats may be moored not more than 25 feet off club property at White's Cove & Third Beach within designated areas.
  - f. Excluding sailboats, no boats are to be stored or left in the water off Club property for more than 24 hours.
  - g. At White's Cove only and with the permission of the Club, handicap members as determined through a State Handicap Parking Permit, may leave their boat in water and/or request a closer/lower storage rack location. Provision 3c still applies.
  
4. **Policy Compliance**
  - a. Failure to comply with any section of this policy can result in loss of Club privileges as determined by the Board.
  - b. All boats utilized on the lake are required to comply with existing NJ State laws and regulations regarding boats & vessels.
